Sec. 1704.210. WITHDRAWAL OF SECURITY. (a) A license holder may withdraw the security or a portion of the security deposited or executed under Section 1704.160, and the security shall be returned to the license holder or the license holder's heirs or assigns, if the person requesting the withdrawal is:

(1) a license holder in good standing and the amount of the security remaining after the withdrawal is:

- (A) at least the minimum amount required by Section 1704.160; and
- (B) an amount sufficient to maintain the ratios required by Section 1704.203;

or

(2) a former license holder who has ceased to engage in the bonding business, or a former license holder's heir or assign, and the amount of the security remaining after the withdrawal is sufficient to:

- (A) pay any outstanding judgments; and
- (B) secure any unexpired obligation on a bail bond executed by the former

license holder.

- (b) The board may adopt rules to limit the number of times in a year security may be returned to a license holder under this section.

#### 7.4 BAIL BOND LIMITS

A. All bonds, issued in Fort Bend County will be subtracted from a Licensee's security for purposes of the Licensee's Bail Bond Limits, including bonds executed in Fort Bend County and transferred to another county. It is the responsibility of the Licensee to provide government issued verification to the Bail Bond Administrator when a case has been dismissed or a defendant is deceased in order to update the amount of security available to the Licensee.

B. The Bail Bond Administrator shall notify the Sheriff of any Licensee that has executed a bond in excess of the Licensee's Bail Bond Limits.

C. The Bail Bond Administrator shall notify the District Attorney's Office that the Licensee's bonds may be insufficient in the event that a Licensee is deceased or becomes incapacitated.

D. If a Licensee is suspended by the Board for any reason, the Licensee will be removed from the Licensed Bail Bond Surety List. Upon reinstatement of the license, the company will be placed at the bottom of the List.
