DEFINITIONS

The following words and terms, when used in these Rules, shall have the following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

- A. <u>Agent</u>: an independent contractor licensed in Fort Bend County as a bail bondsman and contracted by a Corporate Surety to issue bail bonds on behalf of the Corporate Surety.
- B. <u>Applicant</u>: a person seeking to obtain or renew a Corporate Surety, Corporate Surety's Agent or Individual Surety License in Fort Bend County. C. <u>Board</u>: means the Fort Bend County Bail Bond Board.
- D. <u>Bond</u>: cash deposit and any other similar deposit or written undertaking to assure appearance.
- E. <u>Company</u>: an entity engaged in the bail bond business.
- F. County: means Fort Bend County.
- G. <u>Employee</u>: any person who for hire or for any compensation performs work with or on
 - behalf of a Licensee including but not limited to: meets and negotiates with members of the public for the purpose of selling bail bonds; receives money as a fee or money or property as collateral for bail bonds; presents bonds to the Sheriff's Office for approval; and/or interviews or takes information from persons who have been released from jail pursuant to a bond provided by the Licensee.
- H. <u>Licensee</u>: a person licensed hereunder either as an Individual Surety or as Corporate Surety's Agent.
- I. <u>Person</u>: an individual or corporation.
- J. Rules: the Fort Bend County Local Bail Bond Rules
